

Bridal Shower Pictionary

HOW TO PLAY

What do you need?

- Pieces of paper or index cards (to write wedding-related words or phrases)
- Large pad of paper or a whiteboard, an easel will be handy.
- Markers or pens
- Timer (your phone works perfectly)

How do you play?

- **Set up:** Write your wedding-related words or phrases on your pieces of paper or card. We suggest around 15-20, so there is some choice and there are still enough for multiple rounds, just depends how long you want the game to go on.
- **Split into Teams:** Divide the guests into two or more teams, depending on how many are playing. You'll want at least 3-4 people per team to keep things lively.
- **Set Up the Drawing Space:** Designate an area where players will stand to draw. This can be at the front of the room or somewhere everyone can see clearly.
- **Play the Game:** The first player from Team A pulls a wedding-related word or phrase from the bowl. The player has 60 seconds to draw their chosen word while their team guesses. No talking, writing words, or using gestures!
- **Scoring:** If the team guesses correctly within the time limit, they earn a point. If not, the other team gets a chance to steal the point by making a guess.
- **Continue Play:** Keep going until all words are used or until you reach a predetermined score, such as 10 or 15 points.
- The team with the most points at the end wins the game!

Extra Tips

- Tailor your word list to the bride-to-be's interests, the wedding theme, or inside jokes.
- If your group is competitive, throw in a few challenging phrases. For a more laid-back game, stick to easy-to-draw objects and concepts.
- Mix things up with a wildcard round where players can choose any wedding-related word to draw without selecting from the bowl. It adds an extra element of surprise!
