

Guess the Dress

HOW TO PLAY

What do you need?

- Printed Guess the Dress game cards – kraft or colored cardstock is perfect if you want to draw a white dress
- Markers or pens (enough for everyone) – White pencils or markers are great if you print on kraft cardstock or colored paper
- Timer (optional) – If you want to add some extra pressure to the game
- Optional: [A prize for the winner](#)

How do you play?

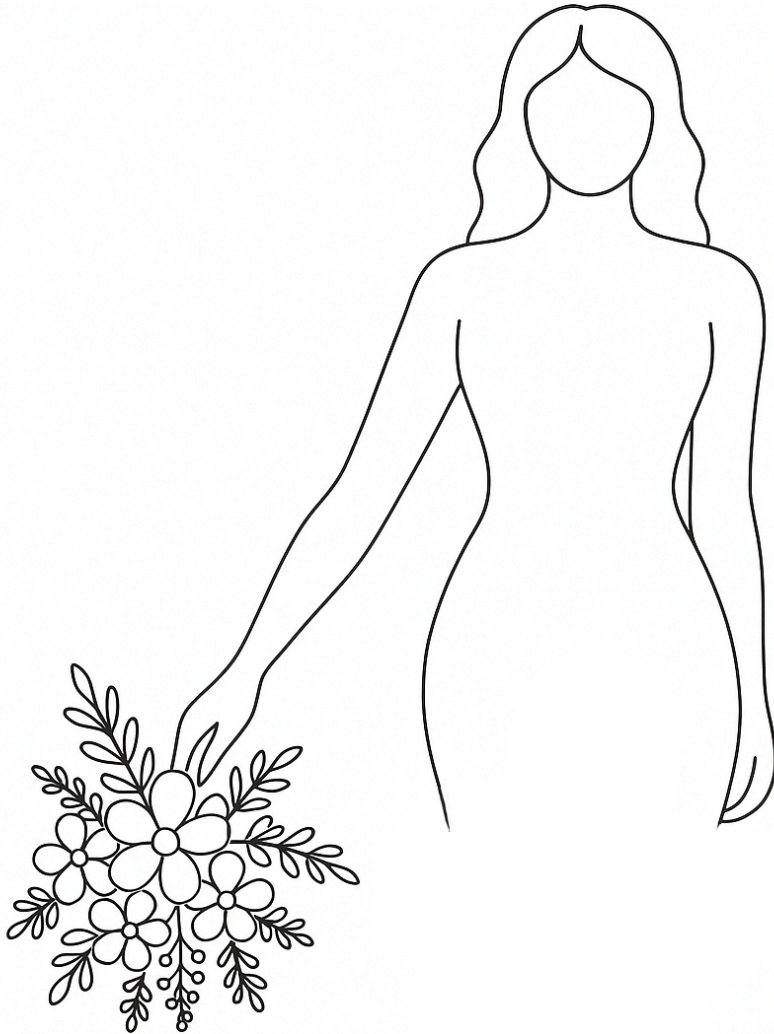
- Give each guest a printable card and a marker. Ask everyone to draw what they think the bride's wedding dress looks like. Emphasize that they must do their best to capture her dream dress based on what they've heard or guessed.
- If you want to keep things quick and fun, set a timer for 3-5 minutes. This adds to the excitement and keeps the game moving.
- Once everyone's ready, start the timer and let the drawing begin!
- After the drawing time is up, have each guest present their card.
- The bride-to-be can decide how the winner will be chosen: either based on the dress that is closest to the actual wedding dress or something more fun, like the funniest, most creative, or most unique interpretation. If the bride wants to, she can describe her actual dress.

Extra Tips

- **Let the bride guess:** If you want to add another layer of fun, play the game so that the bride has to guess who drew each design. This version adds some mystery and a whole new element of entertainment!
- **Take photos of the drawings:** These will make great additions to a bridal shower scrapbook or memory box for the bride to keep.
- **Group voting:** If the bride doesn't want to choose the winner herself, you can have the guests vote on categories like "Most Artistic," "Most Likely to Be on a Runway," or "What Even Is That?"

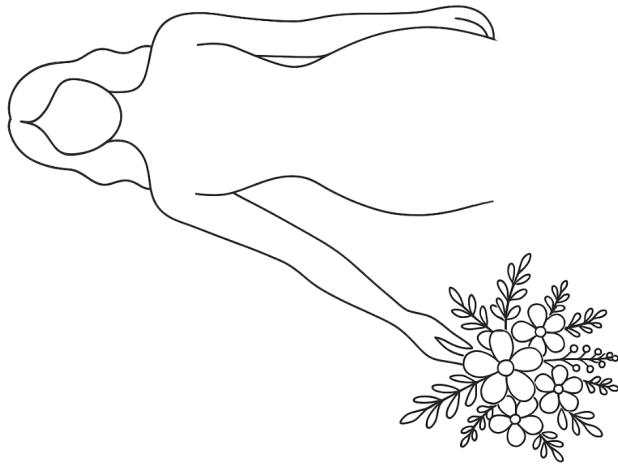
